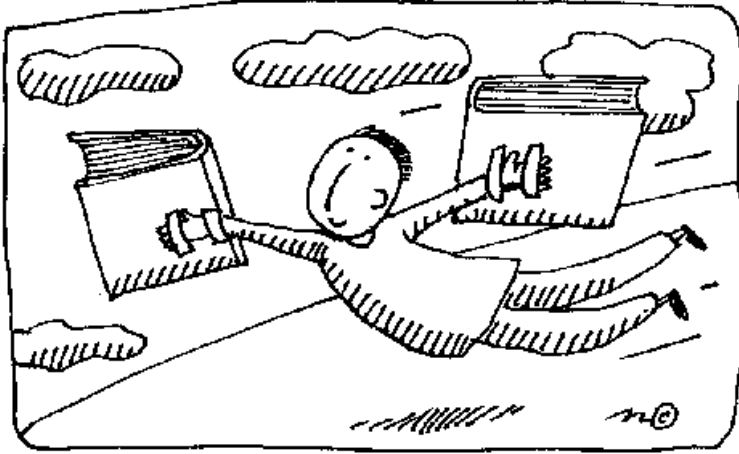


Write On!

Creative Writing Summer Program for Grades 6-HS

Grades Rising 6-8: Writing Circle (Session I and II)

Spend the week playing with different plots and prompts, creating characters, and responding to fellow writers' work.

Grades Rising 9-Completed 12: Writing Workshop (Sessions I, II)

Create new work and polish existing pieces (poetry, fiction, movie scripts, etc.) with supportive feedback from the group.

Grades Rising 6 – Completed 12: Comic Book Writing Camp (A-Term)

Participants will then develop their own original characters and make their own six-panel mini comic book using Laura Lee's favorite blue cartooning pencils and ink pens.

Limit: 10 students per group, per session. Snacks and walks outside will be incorporated into daily activities. At the end of the session, we'll have a reading for parents and friends. Each writer will be published in our camp magazine. Fee includes snacks, writer's notebook, and one copy of the magazine.

All instructors are schoolteachers with creative writing experience. Sessions will be held at WriterHouse, 508 Dale Ave, behind the Preston Avenue Bodo's Bagels. 434-296-1922
