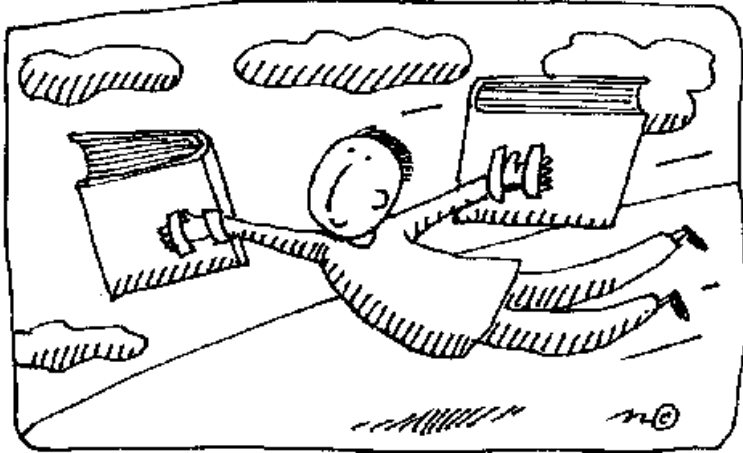


Write On!

Creative Writing Summer Program for Grades 6-HS

Bring your works-in-progress or start something new!



**Session I: Monday-Friday
July 8 – 12, 2019, 1:00-5:00pm**

**Session II: Monday-Friday
July 22 – 26, 2019, 1:00-5:00pm**

Grades Rising 6-8: Writing Workshop (Session I only)

Spend the week playing with different prompts, journaling, and visiting nearby inspiring locations. Writing will include poetry, fiction, and nonfiction. Young writers will share ideas and refine their work.

Grades Rising 9-Completed 12: Writing Workshop (Session I)

Focus on inspiration—where to find it and how to best use it. Draw on your surroundings (through day trips), each other, research, and other artists. Writing, song, graphic art and film will all be sources of inspiration.

Grades Rising 9-Completed 12: Writing Workshop (Session II)

A tailored reading list, a hands-on tour of famous books, time for writing, supportive revision, and writing exercises are included. The week wraps with a review of where to submit your writing.

Limit: 10 students per group, per session. Snacks and walks outside will be incorporated into daily activities. At the end of the session, we'll have a reading for parents and friends. Each writer will be published in our camp magazine. Fee includes snacks, writer's notebook, and one copy of the magazine.

All instructors are schoolteachers with creative writing experience. Sessions will be held at WriterHouse, 508 Dale Ave, behind the Preston Avenue Bodo's Bagels. 434-296-1922
